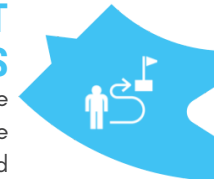
PLANNING FOR IMPACT

A core module focusing on building greater familiarity with programme logics - how to read them and development for yourself.



DEVELOPING IMPACT PATHWAYS

You need to have completed both the core modules first, or be familiar with and used the tools in other work, so you can understand how to use the key tools in more ways.



TRACKING YOUR IMPACT

This module involves more in-depth use of programme logics, the impact planning tool, and introduces and uses several other concepts and tools.

You **MUST** have attended **PLANNING**, and ideally both of the core modules.



COMMUNICATING YOUR IMPACT

This module builds on both the impact planning tool and programme logics, but focuses on using them in different ways.



EXTENDING YOUR IMPACT TOOLBOX

Prerequisites will be case-by-case depending on the focus.
